

The Jay A. Graybeal Scholarship Fund Of the Historical Society of Carroll County

The Jay A. Graybeal Scholarship Fund was established by the Historical Society of Carroll County to honor the many contributions made by Mr. Graybeal to the Historical Society and Carroll County during his tenure as Curator and Executive Director of the Historical Society.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Fund is to provide scholarships to college bound high school students, or students currently enrolled in undergraduate studies or pursuing post-graduate studies in general history or a specialty area of studies in history to include but not limited to; museum studies, archival management, library science, historic preservation, material culture, American Studies, archaeology, anthropology, art or architectural history or preservation technology; or to students pursuing a recognized certification or apprenticeship program dedicated to traditional arts, industries, trades or crafts.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA

Up to two scholarship(s) of \$750 will be awarded each year to the student(s) who meets the criteria listed below.

The Student shall:

- ❖ be a resident of Carroll County for at least one year prior to applying for the scholarship;
- ❖ exhibit exemplary character and have maintained high academic standards;
- ❖ demonstrate diverse interests, with special interests in the areas of the Humanities or Sciences;
- ❖ exhibit extra-curricular, volunteer, work experience with a preference for history or related area.

The recipient shall be nominated by the Historical Society of Carroll County Scholarship Committee, to include faculty from local or regional colleges or institutions, as well as selected community members, and approved by the Board of Directors of the Community Foundation of Carroll County.

APPLICATION AND AWARD PROCEDURES

- ❖ Applicant must complete the Graybeal Scholarship application. Applications may be obtained from the Historical Society offices or website.
- ❖ Applicant must attach transcript(s) to this application. Please write scores in spaces provided; not, "see attached".
- ❖ List your activities both in High School and in the community, including service clubs or projects, sports, civic groups and church activities in which you have taken part.
- ❖ Attach an essay discussing how you believe history has influenced or shaped your future. Essays should be two to five pages in length, using

1" margins; 11 pt. font, double-spaced and include your full name and page number on each page.

- ❖ Attach at least two letters of reference, one from an academic referral and one from a volunteer/internship or similar type of source. Letters of reference from relatives will not be considered.
- ❖ All materials related to the application should be submitted as a complete package. The Historical Society is not responsible for lost or misdirected materials sent under separate cover.
- ❖ Completed applications must be submitted to the Historical Society of Carroll County, 210 E. Main Street, Westminster, MD 21157 no later than the specified deadline. Applications postmarked or received after the deadline will not be considered.

All scholarships funds awarded shall be transmitted directly to the recipient's college or university and applied directly to the student's fees. No monies shall not be remitted to the scholarship winner directly.
